

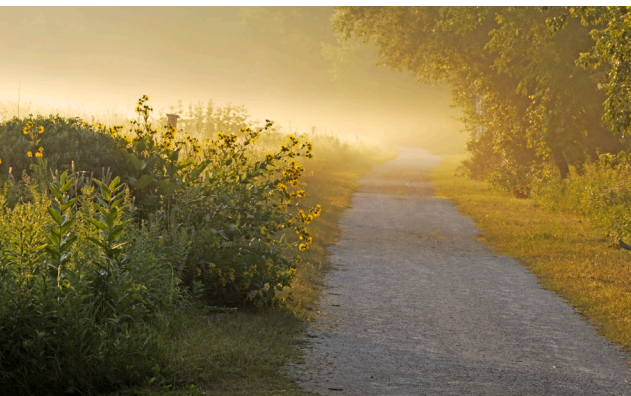
PARK POLICIES

Trail Usage

- Horses, bikes and motorized vehicles are prohibited.
- Trails are groomed for classic skiing in winter. No walking on groomed ski trails.
- Please only hike/snowshoe on snowshoe trails in winter season.
- Please be respectful of private property near park boundaries.
- Mosquito Creek trail is seasonally re-routed during waterfowl migrations. Please follow signs on trail.
- No collecting of plants or animals.
- No fishing.

Pet Policy






- Leashed dogs are allowed south of Lineville Road.
- Pets are prohibited north of Lineville Rd.
- Please clean up after your pets.
- No pets allowed on groomed cross country ski trails.

L.H. Barkhausen Waterfowl Preserve is a 1000 acre Brown County Park located on the West shore of Green Bay. One of the oldest waterfowl preserves in Wisconsin, this public natural area has rich cultural and natural history.

L.H. Barkhausen continues to have an important role in education and environmental preservation in Green Bay.

-  Within the park numerous wetland, hardwood, and prairie habitats provide for a variety of wildlife and plants.
-  With over nine miles of trails for hiking, cross country skiing, and snowshoeing there is sure to be something for everyone to enjoy.
-  Barkhausen offers year-round programs for schools, scouts, and families. Within the park the Nature Center has natural history exhibits and native live animals for visitors to enjoy.
-  The Sensory Woods located off the main parking lot provides an inclusive area for all users to enjoy featuring unique sensory elements.
-  An all-terrain wheelchair is available to use at no charge. Please call ahead to reserve it.

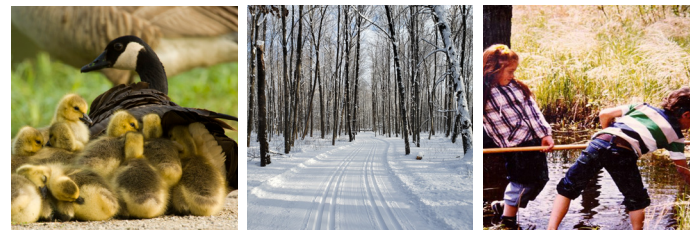
